XI. Ride to Remember update:

1. Ride to Remember 2017 went great! Slushie offered some preliminary numbers, and are as follows. Flag - \$230.00 congratulations Ozzy. Quilt - \$509.00, Basket raffle - \$815.00, Bucket raffle - \$1210.00, Registration - \$2946.00, AM 50/50 - \$315.00, PM 50/50 - \$150.00, Stage Hogs - \$500.00, Shirts - \$20.00, Hats - \$35.00, Jeff Munisteri - \$295.00 Thanks Jeff. Green Bay Auto - \$100.00, and Snap On Tools - \$100.00.
2. Bucket and basket raffles were discussed, specifically, reconsidering the amount allocated to the bucket raffle. It was decided however to table the subject until a meeting when more members were present.
3. Pickers had concerns about gap filling after road blockers peel off during the rides. Our policy is to maintain your line and wave the bike behind up, to fill the gap, to avoid lane switching.
